OCOEE UTILITY DISTRICT SCORES 99% ON SANITARY SURVEY

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation's Division of Water Resources recent sanitary survey has resulted in the Ocoee Utility District achieving a score of 99% (597 out of 599 possible points). This score allows the Ocoee Utility District to remain among Tennessee's approved public water suppliers.

The sanitary survey reviews the complete operation of the utility including plant performance, maintenance and upkeep, record keeping, analysis, treatment techniques and adherence to requirements, distribution quality, the cross connection program, and other quality and maintenance parameters.

The noted deficiencies were a leaking packing seal on a pump and a corroded ladder support bracket on a storage tank. The pump has been adjusted and a new storage tank is currently being designed to replace the existing tank.

The Ocoee Utility District has maintained a score of 95 or higher (the current score necessary to remain among the approved public water providers) for the last twenty years.

The Ocoee Utility District provides water to a population of 21,000 in east Bradley and west Polk Counties.
